The purpose of this grant is to:

1. Provide funding to fellows and early career orthopaedic surgeons to attend courses and conferences that aid in the development of surgical skill and knowledge
2. Support research projects that correlate to the JRGOS' Vision and Mission

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Primary applicant must have completed an accredited orthopaedic surgery residency and:
 - a. Be enrolled as a fellow in an orthopaedic surgery subspecialty training program
 - or
 - b. Be a practicing orthopaedic surgeon less than 10 years from the completion of his or her orthopaedic residency training
2. Applicant must be a member of the JRGOS in good standing
3. If submitting an application to fund a research project the JRGOS must be recognized for its support of the work and upon all subsequent occasions when the data is presented
4. All research grant recipients are required to submit their research abstract to the Orthopaedic Section of the National Medical Association (NMA) annual meeting, and are strongly encouraged to attend the NMA annual meeting
5. No indirect costs are allowed as part of this grant.
