**The purpose of the Medical Student / Resident Research Grant is to support:**

1. Studies that correlate to the JRGOS' Vision and Mission;
2. Studies designed so that a measurable outcome is achieved at the end of the grant cycle.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

1. Primary applicant must be enrolled medical school or be resident physician in an orthopaedic surgery program
2. Applicant must be a member of JRGOS in good standing
3. JRGOS must be recognized for its support of the work and upon all subsequent occasions when the data is presented
4. All research grant recipients are required to submit their research abstract to the Orthopaedic Section of the National Medical Association (NMA) annual meeting, and are strongly encouraged to attend the NMA annual meeting
