



## **J. ROBERT GLADDEN ORTHOPAEDIC SOCIETY DIRECTOR-AT-LARGE**

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### **Overall Purpose/Mission**

Along with the other members of the JRGOS Board of Directors, the Director-at-Large oversees the activities of the Society and ensure the Society is a healthy and viable member organization.

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### **Charges**

1. Participate in the Annual JRGOS in-person Board meeting.
  2. Participate in all JRGOS conference calls; approximately 3 per year.
  3. Develop, oversee the implementation, and evaluate the Society's strategic plan.
  4. Participate in the approval of the Society's annual budget.
  5. Ensure the availability of adequate financial resources.
  6. Be informed of, and meet all, legal and fiduciary responsibilities.
  7. Serve on the Society's committees and/or work groups as assigned; serve as a liaison to external societies' as assigned.
  8. Assist in identifying and recruiting future volunteers.
  9. Ensure Society policies are carried out; modify as needed.
  10. Act as an ambassador for the Society.
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### **Composition**

The number of members on the Board of Directors shall be at least seven (7), but no more than twenty (20).

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### **Appointment**

The Director-at-Large shall be appointed by the Executive Committee. All members of the Board of Directors must hold a current, paid membership during their time on the Board.

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### **Term of Office**

Members shall serve terms of three (3) but not more than six (6) years.
