### **Overall Purpose/Mission**

To design and oversee projects of orthopaedic education and/or research

---

### **Charges**

1. Regularly assesses the state of knowledge in the field of orthopaedics, reviews gaps in knowledge and develops strategies to address unmet needs.
  2. Ensures fiscal responsibility within approved budgets for scientific activities that align with strategic objectives
  3. Establishes grant review processes and criteria
  4. Accepts and reviews funding proposals for research grants throughout the year
  5. Evaluates proposals from members requesting funds for conducting research and determines applicant eligibility
  6. Annually evaluates funding sources and recommends future enhancements to secure future funding
  7. Reports committee actions and activities to the JRGOS Board of Directors and also to the membership during business meetings and in the Society newsletter.

### **Composition**

The number of committee members shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

### **Appointment**

The Chair, Vice-Chair and members of the Scientific Committee shall be appointed by the Executive Committee.
