The JRGOS is sponsoring a Domestic Traveling Fellowship for any young society member (2-3 years in practice). This program is designed to increase surgical skills, learn new techniques, and expand practice interests.

## **The guidelines for the traveling fellowship are as follows:**

1. Duration of the program is four weeks or more.
2. The site can be any institution or practice where a JRGS member is involved.
3. Preference will be given to those candidates who elect to work with a Senior JRGS member.

## **Requirements:**

1. 2-3 years in practice.
2. A member of JRGOS in good standing.
3. Completed application form, which includes proposed visitation site.
4. Letter from JRGOS member in support of applicant.

## **Finances:**

The JRGOS will pay an award of up to \$6,000 to cover reimbursement for travel expenses. Expenses above that amount are the responsibility of the applicant.

## **Reporting:**

The winner will be expected to give a report at the JRGOS annual luncheon, held in conjunction with the AAOS Annual Meeting.
